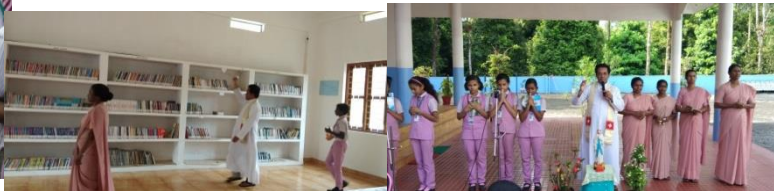
On 12th June, the tiny tots stepped into the crucial turning point in their lives. They are welcomed in to this new world with decorations, colours and songs.

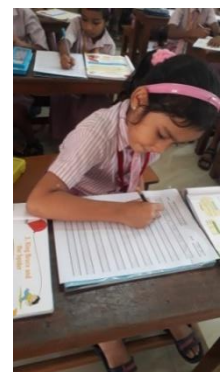


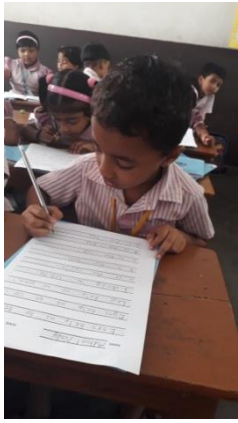
for selecting our school and coming all the way from Bombay. Sessions were very interactive and students participated very
